

Transit Connections to 2010 Winter Games Venues

During the Games, TransLink is adding transit service across the board to get you where you want to go. More frequent SkyTrain service, extra SeaBus sailings, special West Coast Express evening and weekend trains, and more buses offering more connections - including extended late-night service on many routes. All Games venues in Metro Vancouver are served by major transit routes from various parts of our region.

While there are many transit options for getting to Games venues, below are the recommended stations/stops for each venue.

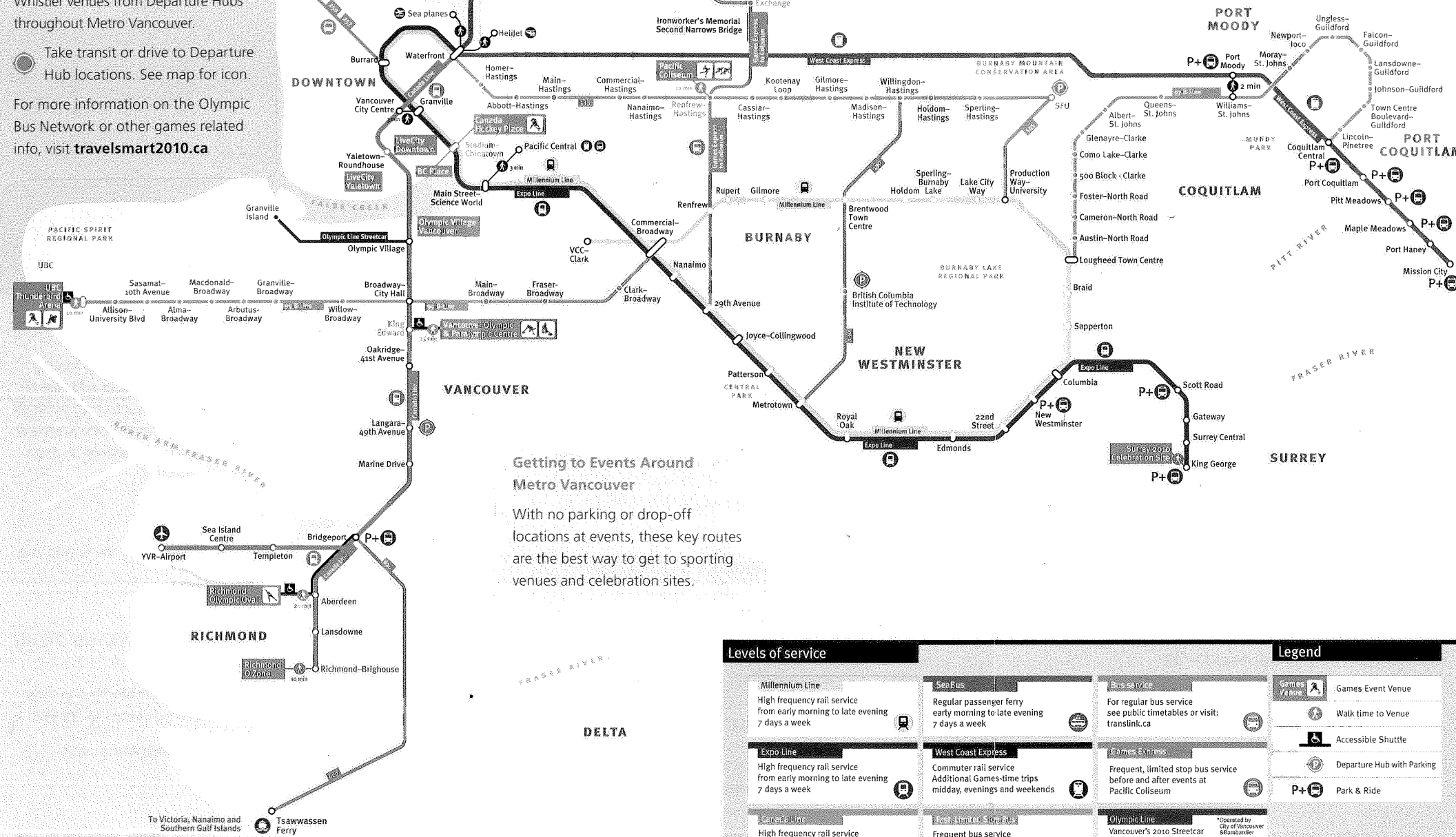
Getting to Mountain Venues
