




This adapter reduces the volume of a playing BGM track. The volume reduction of normal sound is adjustable by two pots on the board. Standard in OMT CD and New York, NY.




This Background-Connector can be used to pipe an external stereo source (radio, cassette player) by the jukebox, or the jukebox sound can be reproduced by an existing music and background system.


VIII. MICROPHONE KIT (40 090 000 00)

This unit enables the use of the phonograph as a paging system, when playing as well as during idling periods. If the paging microphone is switched on while the phonograph is playing, the music fades away for this period. The volume of the microphone is adjustable at the pre-amplifier box. A cable length of 15 meters (approx. 50 feet) allows to install this kit in distance to the jukebox.






